Farmington and Dakota County to Hold Open House for Pilot Knob Trail Project

Farmington, Minn., Jan. 18, 2024 – The City of Farmington is hosting an open house to discuss the Pilot Knob Trail Project Tuesday, Jan. 30 from 5 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. in the atrium of Farmington City Hall, 430 Third St.

The Open House is about a proposed multi-use trail on the east side of Pilot Knob Road (CSAH 31) between Elm Street (CSAH 50) and 195th Street (CSAH 64). We're proposing to construct a ten-foot-wide, multi-use asphalt trail for pedestrians and bicyclists on the east side of Pilot Knob Road and connecting a trail gap on the west side of Pilot Knob just south of 197th St. Project goal is to eliminate the need for users to cross Pilot Knob to access the existing trail thus improving safety, mobility, and connectivity along Pilot Knob.

City and County staff will share details about the project, discuss potential project impacts, and answer questions and take input and feedback. Concept drawings of proposed improvements will be available for review. If the project is approved, the city and county will work together to fund the project and to pursue grant opportunities and programs.
